- + we talked about recording Jason's presentation
- + in the old Science Building there was a large room with many machines in it called the Unix Lab. it was just down the hall from the CS Department office and students would come by before or after class to work on assignments or just to socialize. the Unix operators had their own office separated from the larger room with a door and a window. beyond the operators were the Unix servers for the department. the operators hung out in the room and they often helped students with their assignments. many former students have fond memories of the place and some said that they learned more in the lab than in their courses.
- + Glenn and Tom have been working on a plan to get more people to come to the CS Lab to get help and socialize. their idea is to wall off a small part of the CS Lab as an office for the operators. Tom is reluctant to let the Unix operators perform many tasks because they work in the open where everyone can see what they are doing. but if they had an enclosed space with a door and a window, they could do more work. having the operators there doing system work, might encourage students to come by since the operators

know a lot and could help them with their problems. to get this proposal approved, we may need to talk to the Dean of Science and if that happens, I would like one or two students to come along. Glenn has been going to the CS Lab every Wednesday from about 3-5
